
Thank you for your letter of 31 October'94 conveying your views on Green Cross India and the Parliamentarians Environment Group.

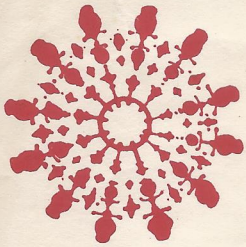
